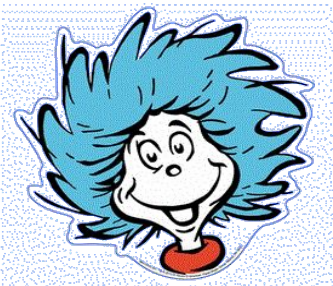


# Read Across America Week
